PRAY—READ & STUDY—OBEY

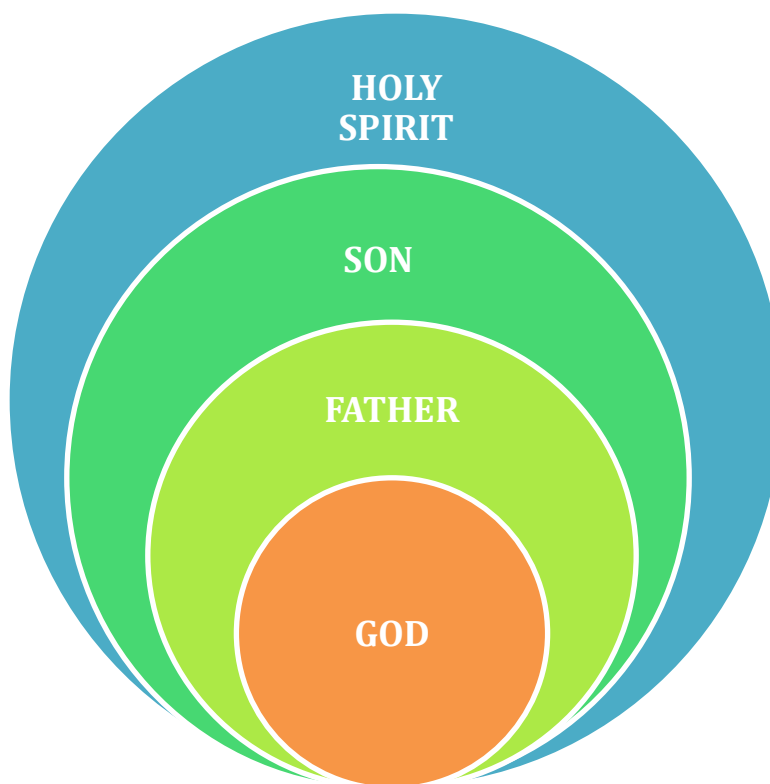

THE HOLY BIBLE

The Holy Bible is the written Word of God to mankind! Holy refers to God's dominate attribute of being wholly Righteous—Moral—Perfect. God's very nature is Holy: Pure-Undeified-Sinless (*Ref. Leviticus 11:44; 1 Peter 1:15-16*).

God's supreme purpose & passion for the Holy Bible is to reveal Himself—in the person & work of The LORD Jesus Christ—the One & only Saviour of the world. (*Ref. Hebrews 1:1-3; John 3:1-21*)

The word "Bible" comes from Greek and ancient writings—meaning "book of books." It contains 66 books divided into two sections—Old Testament (O.T.)—39 books and New Testament (N.T.)—27 books. The O.T. was originally written in Hebrew and Aramaic, while the N.T. was written in Greek. (Sources: Nelson's Bible Dictionary & Zondervan's Encyclopedias)

INTRODUCTION

DO YOU HAVE 30 MINUTES+ PER DAY TO GIVE YOURSELF WHOLLY UNTO THE LORD?

—It is an act of your will; an attitude of your heart!

“Delight thyself also in the Lord; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart. Commit thy way unto the Lord; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.”

Psalm 37:4-5

The goal of this “30 Minute+ Bible Study Plan” is to exhort & challenge Christians to spend at least 30 minutes per day reading and studying the WORD of GOD (a.k.a. The Holy Scriptures—The Holy Bible). Consider the following Scriptures:

- a. *“Study to shew thyself approved unto GOD, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”
(2 Timothy 2:15)*
- b. *“As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the Word, that ye may grow thereby:” (1 Peter 2:2)*

INTRODUCTION (continued)

- c. *“But He (JESUS) answered and said, ‘It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of GOD.’” (Matthew 4:4)*
- d. *“All Scripture is given by inspiration of GOD, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:” (2 Timothy 3:16)*

I feel confident that the majority of Christians believe God’s word is all important and should occupy a significant portion of our daily lives. However, the cares of this world, legitimate or not, tend to crowd out the very things we believe to be of utmost importance. *“For the flesh lusteth (wars) against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh...” (Galatians 5:17; Ref. Matthew 13:22)*

My heart’s desire and prayer to God for each of us—is for the Lord’s grace to abound in our daily lives; and that we will honor His Son—The Lord Jesus Christ, by giving God’s Holy Word the preeminence it deserves.

FOUNDATIONS

A lifestyle of purpose & passion for the Word of God will produce in us—a firm foundation for the glory of Christ. To serve the Lord we must be willing to study & apply His Holy Word in our daily lives—that we may grow in respect to salvation. *(Ref. 1 Peter 2 :2)*

Fathers are commanded by God to bring up their children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. We must seek to discover & understand our own purpose in Christ in order to lead & guide our children and others into the same. *(Ref. Ephesians 6 :4)*

The Lord has given each of us an opportunity to pray and act on behalf of our children even prior to their conception; remember Hannah, in the book of 1st Samuel. How much more does the Lord require of parents—now that our children are here. *(Ref. 1 Samuel 1 & 2)*

PRINCIPLES

*Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not
To be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.*

2 Timothy 2:15

The plan of action is to set aside 30 minutes+ each day for comprehensive study of the Word of God. Genesis thru Revelation:

Book by Book—Chapter by Chapter—Verse by Verse!

The neglect of God's Holy Word is clear evidence of living in the flesh (carnal lifestyle) rather than living by the Holy Spirit. *(Ref. Galatians 5:16-17)*

God has commanded us to put off the old man (former lifestyle), which is corrupt in accordance with the lusts (desires) of deceit, and be renewed in the spirit of our minds; and that we put on the new man, which in the likeness of God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

(Ref. Ephesians 4:22-24; Romans 6:6)

You and I cannot live a godly life without a "Passion"

For understanding & applying God's Holy Word!

PRINCIPLES (continued)

EPHESIANS

“This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk

Not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,

Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God

Through the ignorance that is in them,

Because of the blindness of their heart:

Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work

All uncleanness with greediness.

But ye have not so learned Christ;

If so be that ye have heard Him, and have been taught by Him,

As the truth is in Jesus:

That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man,

Which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

- Remove distractions
- Be consistent
- Apply Liberty—not legalism:
- The law is a ministry of death!

Hath made me free from the law of sin and death.”*

-You may also listen to the Scriptures on various media platforms & follow along in your Bible: However, there is no substitute for reading God’s word with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength. (*Ref. Mark 12:30*)

-Read objectively: Let God’s word speak for itself-avoid presuppositions. Try not to read additional thoughts into God’s word based on tradition or your own paradigm.

-Meditate on key Understandings (Principles & Practices) of what you learned.

“...Be Courageous and Act.” 1 Chronicles 28:10 (NASB)

“...Be Strong and Do It.” 1 Chronicles 28:10 (KJV)

GUIDELINES (continued)

1. Begin with Prayer (*Colossians 1:9*)

- a. *“Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.” (Philippians 4:6)*
- b. *“Shew me Thy ways, O LORD; teach me Thy paths. Lead me in Thy truth, and teach me: for Thou art the God of my salvation; on Thee do I wait all the day.” (Psalm 25:4-5)*

2. Read THE HOLY BIBLE (*2 Kings 23:2*)

- a. Read the Holy Scriptures slowly & carefully (*2 Timothy 2:15*)
- b. Read for Comprehension & Understanding (*2 Timothy 3 :16*)
- c. Trust the Lord Jesus Christ to “open your understanding.”
(*Luke 24:45, John 16:13*)

3. Interpret THE HOLY BIBLE (*2 Peter 1:20-21*)

- a. Compare Scripture with Scripture (*1 Corinthians 2:13*)
- b. Concordance & Bible Dictionary: verify word definitions & usage

4. Record Key Scriptures, Principles & Practice (Deuteronomy 6)

a. *“...The LORD our God is one LORD: And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.”*

(Deuteronomy 6:4-9)

b. *“Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it...” (Deuteronomy 4:2)*

c. *“Add thou not unto His (God’s) words, lest He reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.” (Proverbs 30:6)*

d. *"...If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book."*

(Revelation 22:18-19)

5. Meditate (re-think) on Lessons Learned (Psalm 1)

a. *"Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in His law doth he meditate day and night." (Psalm 1:1-2)*

b. *"This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth: but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success."*

(Joshua 1:8)

6. Faith: (Belief & Trust) Obeying the revealed will of God (Genesis 15:1-6)
 - a. *“Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.” (Genesis 6:22)*
 - b. *“And he (Abram) believed in the LORD; and He counted it to him for righteousness.” (Genesis 15:6)*
 - c. *“Take heed now; for the LORD hath chosen thee to build an house for the sanctuary: be strong, and do it.” (1 Chronicles 28:10)*
 - d. *“But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.” (Hebrews 11:6)*

*“Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith;
Who for the joy that was set before Him

7. Share God's Truth with others (Psalm 145)

(Psalm 145:4, 11-12)*
- b. *"I will remember the works of the LORD: surely I will remember Thy wonders of old. I will meditate also of all Thy work, and talk of Thy doings. Thy way, O God, is in the sanctuary: who is so great a God as our God?" (Psalm 77:11-13)*
- c. *"The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise." (Proverbs 11:30)*
- d. *"And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever." (Daniel 12:3)*

APPENDIX B: BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ENGLISH BIBLE

HISTORY: THE ENGLISH BIBLE

The Holy Bible (aka “The Book”) is the written word of God! Holy refers to God’s dominate attribute of being wholly Righteous—Moral—Perfect. God’s very nature is Holy: Pure-Undeified-Sinless (*Ref. Leviticus 11:44; 1 Peter 1:15-16*). God’s supreme purpose & passion of the Holy Bible is to reveal Himself—in the person of The LORD Jesus Christ—the One & only Saviour of the world. (*Ref. Hebrews 1:1-3; John 3:1-21*)

The word “Bible” comes from Greek and ancient writings—meaning “book of books.” It contains 66 books divided into two sections—Old Testament (O.T.)—39 books and New Testament (N.T.)—27 books. The O.T. was originally written in Hebrew and Aramaic, while the N.T. was written in Greek.

Today there are a number of Bible translations into English from these and other languages. Some of these translators suffered tremendous persecution and some were even martyred for their efforts to preserve The Word of God and distribute it to as many people as possible. God has continued to preserve His word—The Holy Bible—for all who desire to know the truth and willing to be set free thereby. The following is a brief summary of the English translations throughout history: (Sources: Nelson’s Bible Dictionary, Rose Publishing & Zondervan’s Encyclopedias)
